It's OK to be Insensitive.

Actually, it's better than OK! Case Insensitivity for Searching

Have you ever searched for something in the VPCR and couldn't find it – even though you knew it had to be there?

Case insensitivity - one of the upcoming VPCR enhancements - will improve your VPCR experience.

Searching Today: You must use the proper upper case or lower case letter and hope it matches what was typed into the VPCR.

Example: "smith" does not give you "Smith."

To find Smith, you must use the upper case "S" or type in "~like smith."

Searching in April: "smith" will now give you "Smith."

Case insensitivity and other search improvements will apply to searches on: First Name, Last Name, Street Address, City and Provider.

Bonus: Looking for a last name but you're not sure how to spell it? Just type in the first few letters in the last name field and you'll get a list of all contacts whose names start with those letters!
