

Daily Abuse and Neglect Case Advisory

The Daily Abuse and Neglect Case Advisory is a list of all cases of abuse and neglect called into the Justice Center's Vulnerable Person Central Register (VPCR) in the past 24 hours. Social Services Law §492(3)(b) requires the Justice Center to notify the appropriate district attorney or law enforcement agency when the VPCR receives a report of allegations of criminal conduct or other acts or circumstances that may constitute an immediate threat to the health, safety or welfare of a service recipient. The "Daily Abuse and Neglect Case Advisory" contains cases that the Justice Center believes may meet this criteria, including cases that it has preliminary classified as either criminal or non-criminal, or those that include both categories of allegations. All cases of abuse and neglect called into the VPCR undergo an administrative investigation. Below is an explanation of the terms contained in the Daily Abuse and Neglect Case Advisory. KEY to the "Daily Abuse and Neglect Case Advisory"

Case Serial Number	The Justice Center's case number also referred to as "CSN" in the subject line of the email.
Case Reported Date	The date of the report to the Vulnerable Persons' Central Register (VPCR).
Narrative	The description of the incident as reported to the Justice Center's Intake Unit / VPCR Call Center. NOTE: within the narrative there may appear the "?" symbol in places where an apostrophe, colon or quotation marks should be. This is due to the formatting process of the software used to generate the reports.
Parent Provider Name	Name of the State Oversight Agency or Parent agency with authority over the actual facility or program providing services where the incident being reported is alleged to have occurred.
Provider Name	Name of the facility or program where the incident being reported is alleged to have occurred, which is often referred to by its geographical address/location (e.g., 161 Delaware Ave IRA).
Street Address, City and Zip	Address/location of the facility or program whether the incident is alleged to have occurred.
County	County of the Parent Provider. Note that often the Parent Provider is in one county, with facilities located in several counties.
County of Incident	The County of the incident as reported to Intake/VPCR Call Center.
Occurred Date	Date of incident, if different from the date of report, if known by reporter.
Victim Name	Provided if known
Victim Date of Birth	Provided if known
Suspect Name	Provided if known
